Best practices to keep your fleet safe:

- Administer COVID-specific training
- Social distancing of 6 feet or greater
- Delayed/staggered Starts
- Assigning or clustering of vehicle users
- Increased routine janitorial cleaning
- Documented pre-trip/post trip inspections that include sanitizing surfaces
- Specific COVID-19 inspections
- Routine sanitizing of vehicles by outside service
- PPE for essential operations that are occurring within 6'
